

COCKTAIL HOUR

Soft music, such as classical, jazz, or selections of your choosing, will be played as your guests arrive.

INTRODUCTION OF THE BRIDE & GROOM AND BRIDAL PARTY

This can be low-key and very traditional or you can make it very exciting by choosing a song that will really pump up your guests, bringing them to their feet as you enter the room.

BRIDE & GROOM'S FIRST DANCE

The Bride & Groom will choose their favorite song to dance to. The parents and bridal party can be invited to join in half way through the song. Or they can have a separate song immediately following the first dance, depending on what the Bride & Groom chose.

TOAST

The Best Man usually does this before dinner. We will make the announcement of the toast shortly before it is to take place, so that everyone can have a full glass to toast the newlyweds with.

BLESSING (if applicable)

A clergy member or a relative usually does the blessing if requested.

DINNER

This is where Elegance & Co. shines. We don't believe in wasting your money by sitting down and eating dinner with your guests. We will focus on playing memorable and unobtrusive songs that will have your guests reminiscing through the times. Slow, love songs could also be played for couples that want to take advantage of the open dance floor.

FATHER & DAUGHTER DANCE / MOTHER & SON DANCE

These songs are chosen by the Bride & Groom. We have many suggestions if you are having trouble coming up with a selection of your own.

PARTY MUSIC

We will invite everyone to gradually join in as we get the party started.

CAKE CUTTING

We've got some great music that will flow nicely with your cake-cutting extravaganza. We will coordinate the timing of this event with the Host/Hostess in charge of passing out the cake.

BOUQUET & GARTER TOSS

This can be as much fun as you want to make it. We will discuss the particulars of this event when we meet with you one-on-one.

THE MONEY DANCE OR OTHER PARTICIPATION DANCES

The Bride & Groom will decide if they want to include a Money Dance, or dances like the Macarena, Chicken Dance, Electric Slide, etc. If the Bride & Groom do not want any of these dances requested and played, we will respect their wishes first and foremost.

LAST DANCE

The Bride & Groom will once again choose a song of their liking. They can claim the last dance as their own or request others to join in.
